## Doyle Arts Pavilion Seeking Student Submissions for Mass Appeal Juried Exhibition

Artist Heriberto Luna Will Select Winners to receive cash awards



Students have until Tuesday, April 5 to submit their artwork to Orange Coast College's "Mass Appeal 2022 Juried Student Exhibition" at the Frank M. Doyle Arts Pavilion, scheduled for May 3–12. "Mass Appeal 2022" showcases talent from across the campus, including various artistic media such as painting, drawing, sculpture, ceramics and fashion.

A public reception will take place on Thursday, May 5, from 5–7 p.m. with awards announced during this time. Admission for the event is free and includes food and drinks.

"This will be the first in-person Mass Appeal since 2019, due to COVID-19 precautions. The uniqueness of 'Mass Appeal 2022' is that it's open to the entire Orange Coast College campus, not just to students majoring in art. It's a very democratic process that also represents the abundance of artistic inspiration among

OCC's students," says Tyler Stallings, director of the Doyle Arts Pavilion.

This year's "Mass Appeal 2022" will be in The Doyle's Main Gallery, and will be juried by noted artist, Heriberto Luna. He will select work and chose three works that will receive OCC Foundation Scholarship cash awards of \$500 (First Place), \$400 (Second Place), and \$300 (Third Place). Concurrent with "Mass Appeal 2022" is a sold exhibition of Heriberto Luna's work in the Project Gallery. Luna's invitation to be a juror and solo exhibition is a collaboration with OCC's CLEEO (Counseling Latin@s for Equity & Engagement).
